Understanding the power of SPHM equipment is one thing. Raising awareness of ADA compliance and gaining access to SPHM equipment in your day-to-day work is another.

One recommended strategy involves organizing efforts into "the four Ps": **Projects, Process, People, and Products:**

Project

- Healthcare worker injury investigation
- Patient injury investigation
- New construction or renovation projects

- Conduct "Go and See"
- Observe workflow and interview all staff (including providers)

- Organization's initiatives (i.e. safety, quality, work/culture)
- Data
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- Track occurrences when patients need assistance with transfers; emphasize patients' mobility, not size only
- Conduct A3 process improvement

People

- Senior Leaders
- Disability Management
- Quality & Safety
- Employee Health
- Worker's Compensation
- Case Managers

Product

- Conduct "Go and See"
- Use a location that already has on-site equipment demonstrations
- Trial & evaluate equipment
- Consider buying refurbished equipment if available for lower price
- Consider sharing equipment

- Conduct a "show and tell" for the C-suite and other influencers and decision-makers
